

The DCC's GOBA sag truck is nearly full

As of May 3, 56 people have registered for the Dayton Cycling Club's GOBA sag service. This means we are nearly full. If you have registered for the Great Ohio Bicycle Adventure and would like a few amenities in camp every night, it would be wise to sign up for the DCC's GOBA sag immediately.


GOBA participants will gather Saturday, June 14, in Wellington. The tour starts June 15 with a 60-mile trek to Galion; followed by a 48-mile ride to Mount Vernon for two nights; a 46-mile jaunt to Coshocton for two nights; a 58-mile (jelly) roll to Orrville, home of Smucker's; and a 44-mile pedal back to Wellington on Saturday, June 21. The "days off" include optional loop rides of about 50 to 100 miles.

Team Minardi has volunteered to ease the way for DCC members and friends by offering a sag service. Mark Minardi will not guarantee tailwinds or closeness to toilets or showers, but he will haul your gear in a rental truck and see to it that there are ice-cold drinks and light snacks awaiting you each day in a tarp-shaded group camping spot in GOBAville. All of this personalized service comes at the bargain rate of \$50 per person.

Kay will handle registration and other organizational duties. Five-year-old Clara's job will be to provide (unintended) entertainment for adults and ask her parents constantly for food and drink. She also plays well with other young children.

Participants must have a sense of humor and be willing to help the driver and other participants as needed. In return, participants may bring lawn chairs in addition to the normal one large or two small bags they normally would bring to GOBA. Please label all of your bags, chairs and equipment with your name.

Note that there will be a meeting for DCC GOBA sag participants at 4:30 p.m. Saturday in Wellington. If you are at the Lorain County Fairgrounds at that time, join us for a brief reunion and run-through of the rules for the week. Look for the DCC banner and pop-up tarps. We'll have iced soft drinks waiting for you.
