The Dayton Cycling Club Board of Directors met at 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, June 4, 2008, at the Vandalia Justice Center, 245 James Bohanan Drive. In attendance were directors Chris Brown, Marian and Bob Eley, Harv Kiesel, Beverly Owens, Sally Pinnell, Michele Rizzardi, Brenda Taulbee, Kay Wert Minardi, Tom Wilson and Ed Witte. Members Bud Bell, Joe Casto, Anita Patten, Bob Pinnell, Roger Rizzardi and Chuck Smith also attended.

President Ed Witte called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m.

Witte reported that he was contacted by Bobby Phillips, who asked for volunteers to help conduct the July 19 USA Cycling-sanctioned "Troy Classic on the Square" race.

Witte also announced that the new DCC secretary, Donna Powell, will be in attendance at the July business meeting.

Vice President Brenda Taulbee had nothing to report.

Treasurer Michelle Rizzardi reported that she recently paid the insurance premium for the Huffman Spring Classic. She then asked for a volunteer to be the signature person for Key Bank. Sally Pinnell volunteered to do this. Rizzardi will be renewing the Jo Glover bond at Fifth Third Bank this month. Wilson moved to accept the treasurer's report, and Brown seconded the motion. There was no opposition.

DCC member Chuck Smith recently attended a Bicycle Friendly Communities workshop in Dayton. He would like to see a director of advocacy position again added to the DCC board, to promote bicycling. This is a position he would be happy to fill.

Smith also noted that the Blue Streak Time Trials would resume June 18 at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base. The DCC website will have all the information posted. Those who wish to race should contact Smith directly by the Thursday before the time trial so he can be sure that security officers allow them on base.

Smith updated everyone on House Bill 390. It is still in the Ohio House. It doesn't look good for getting passed during the current legislative session. Also, this is the last year that the bill's sponsor, Arlene Setzer, will be serving as a state representative. Smith thanked those present and the club for supporting the bill.

Marian and Bob Eley reported on the May 18

Huffman Spring Classic. They had hoped for more day-of-ride participants but were happy with the turnout they got. They ended up with 144 participants, including 13 volunteers who rode. They had 13 no-shows. Although we do not refund registration fees, Marian mailed shirts to the no-shows who had ordered them. Most of the registrations came from the DCC website or the newsletter. The ride brought in \$2,866, although \$200 was lost on the T-shirts. Marion pointed out that enough shirts were ordered for two years, so ultimately there should not be a loss. White Allen Subaru sponsored the ride and contributed \$1,600, although nobody from the dealership showed up on the day of the ride. The Eleys had asked for e-mail addresses on the registration form and will send e-mail reminders for next year's ride.

Next year is the 35th anniversary of the ride, and Marian hopes to offer a commemorative jersey for the occasion. Witte thanked the Eleys for their year of hard work on the Huffman Spring Classic.

Newsletter Editor Kay Wert Minardi distributed the minutes from the April 2 and May 7 business meetings. Patten asked the board to clarify in the April minutes that DCC members may list out-of-state rides for touring credit as long as they are open to having other DCC members join them on said rides. Tom Wilson made a motion to accept the April minutes with that amendment, Kiesel seconded, and the board unanimously agreed. Taulbee moved to accept the May minutes as presented, Owens seconded and the board again agreed without opposition.

Membership Director Sally Pinnell said 10 new members joined from May 8 to June 3. Club membership as of June 4 consists of 278 family members in 119 families; 300 adults; one junior and six honorary members, for a total of 585 members. She added that about 30 people whose membership expired in May have not renewed.

Pinnell also said the new club patches are in. They cost the club \$1.25 apiece, and will be sold for \$2 each.


Bikeways Director Chris Brown said he had traveled the Great Miami River Recreation Trail in an attempt to check on the many detours due to road and bridge construction. He said most are fairly well marked.

He added that due to the frequent storms, many of the area bikeways were under water.

Webmaster Harv Kiesel had nothing to report.


In old business, Wert Minardi told the board the newsletter currently costs about 19.6 cents per copy to print. If the numbers were reduced to 200, it would cost the DCC about 21.3 cents per copy. The amount per copy would not substantially become lower until we were printing thousands of copies; she was quoted in the range of 13 cents per copy if we printed 2,000. Patten suggested changing our distribution to two quarterly newsletters (January/February/March and October/November/December) plus monthly issues for April, May, June, July, August and September to save money. After much discussion of the pros and cons, Wilson moved to accept this change. Bob Eley seconded, and the motion was unanimously approved.

Wert Minardi also told the board 93 people were signed up for the DCC's GOBA sag service.

Brown moved to adjourn the meeting; Rizzardi seconded, and the board concurred. The meeting adjourned at 7:32 p.m.

•Every few weeks I will update the touring mileage report on the DCC website. Turning in tour rosters quickly will help me keep the mileage report as up to date as possible.

Attempts to mark trail detour all for naught

After the Miami Conservancy District (MCD) took the time to provide a detour from RiverScape MetroPark to Carillon Historical Park and even put up orange “Detour” signs with little bicycles on them, the construction company charged with replacing the Stewart Street bridge informed the MCD that it needed more space on Patterson Boulevard — the week work was to begin!

This required MCD to close the entire bike path on both banks between RiverScape and Stewart Street. Patterson Boulevard’s northbound lanes are closed and

one of the previous southbound lanes is now the new northbound lane.

While it may be possible for an *experienced* cyclist to negotiate his or her way through traffic (and you did not hear that from me!), the average bikeway rider would have extreme difficulty trying to get from the Carillon Park area, crossing Patterson Boulevard traffic, up to Vietnam Veterans Parkway. So, for the next 16 months or so, I strongly recommend the Creekside Trail and the Little Miami Scenic Trail.

Bikeway Mileage Report

Bikeway miles are those ridden on a non-listed ride, at least half of which is on a bikeway.

Qualify for the Cyclo-Path Award by accumulating 125 *non-repeating* miles on recreational path rides. For example, if you ride from Fifth Third Gateway Park in Beavercreek to Xenia Station and back, you would have ridden 20 bikeway miles, but only 10 of them would count toward your 125 Cyclo-Path miles.

DCC on way to record commuting year

I am happy to report that the Dayton Cycling Club's total of 42,566 commuter miles in the first half of the year puts us on a pace that should eclipse all previous years. If the July through December total equals the first half of the year's, we will easily break our one-year commuting record of 82,081 miles logged last year.

Bicycle commuting makes the news

Monthly Ride List

How to select a club ride

Monthly *Spoke 'N' Link* ride lists include an area, length and speed classification for each ride. The area column gives a general indication of where each ride starts and ends. All rides are in Ohio and are loops, unless otherwise noted.

Ride classification (Class) and length (Miles) of the ride

are important considerations for riders when selecting rides to participate in. The speed classification gives a general idea of the speed riders will be expected to maintain during a ride. Ride leaders are responsible for providing maps and/or accompanying riders unfamiliar with the route.

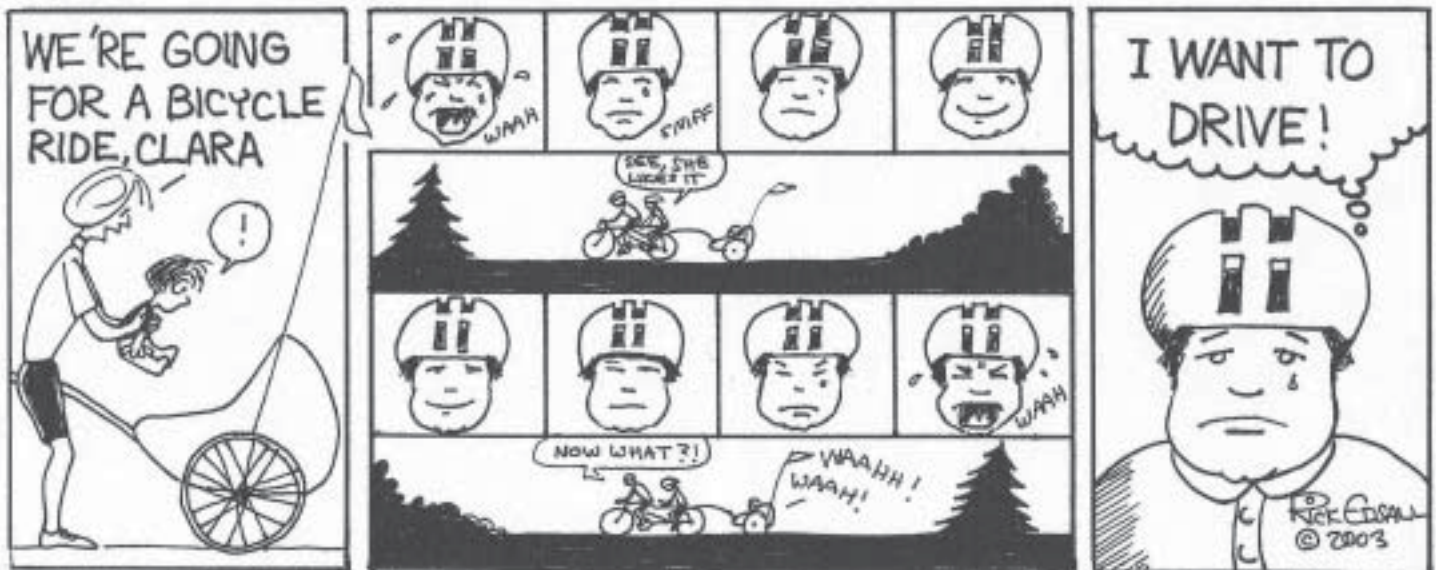
